Enjoy the scenery and paddle at your own pace!

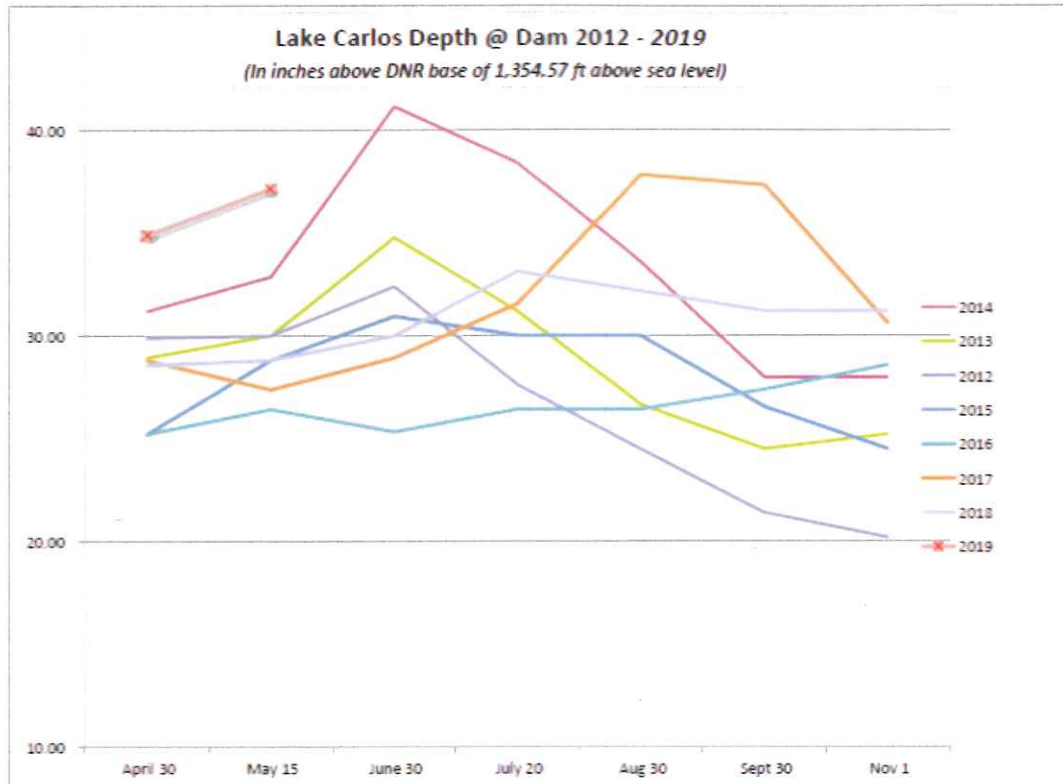

Lake Level

The water level of Lake Carlos is currently on pace to be an all-time high. The level as of May 25th was 11 inches above the same date last year. Last year the level went up another 5 inches and peaked on July 22, 2018. The current level is only 4.2 inches below the 2003 all-time high. **Please travel at no-wake speed near shore and keep wake boats in the middle of the lake. Avoid damaging the shoreline.**



Tent Caterpillar (worm) Spraying

LCAA does not encourage spraying unless there is an infestation of tent caterpillars. Spraying may have unintended impacts on non-threatening caterpillars, worms, and butterflies. If there is a tent caterpillar worm infestation, LCAA will help coordinate neighborhood spraying as has been done over the past few years.
